Interactive and jointly created multimedia guides


- Implemented by Centropa, the Ravansbruck Memorial Museum, Jewish Museum Galicia (Poland), BerlinHistoryApp, the Centre for Eduacation Policy (Serbia)
- Funded by The Foundation Remembrance, Responsibility and Future (EVZ)
- From November 2020-June 2022
- Students from Belgrade, Hamburh and Krakow researched WWII sites of Nazi persecution to create multimedia city guides for peers

Serbian team & activities

- 30 students from Third and Fifth Belgrade Gymansium, led by four teachers
- Online and in-person worshops with historians and experts
- Field visitis to sites: Topovske Šupe, Old Fairground (Staro sajmiste), Banjica Concetration Camp Museum...
- Collaboration with German and Polish stuents via Zoom and Edmodo

Created 3 interactive tours in the BerlinHistory App (in English and Serbian):


- 1. Belgrade's Prisons during Nazi Occupation

- Invited to present at Centropa Summer Academy 2021 to educators worlwide
- Public promotion on 18 Feb 2022 at the Jewish Cultural Center in Belgrade
- Gained hisotrical knowledge, digital skills, and international collaboration expirience



Present stories through new media: films, graphic novels, VR, AR, digital apps


