

## Personal Stories: A Podcast of Honor and Memory

Age group: 13-14 years old

Class: English/Language Arts

### Materials:

- Chromebooks
- Internet access
- Canva software
- Word processing software

### Description:

#### Personal Stories: A Podcast of Honor and Memory

Based on student selected topics after spending two class periods exploring the Centropa website, students will conduct research on individuals located in various cities/countries. Subsequently, they will document facets of their life as a whole - background, geography, family members, involvement in sports, recipes, weddings, children, careers, interests, hobbies. (5 class periods) They will also be tasked with writing at least 3 questions they could possibly ask to propel awkward pauses within the conversation. Students will be divided into Podcast Teams of 3 people, each armed with their research. Students will have a Podcast discussion regarding their respective individuals, comparing/contrasting/bringing insight to their classmates' research/taking questions from the audience, etc. Students will create a final word of honor and memory to conclude the podcast.

# **Personal Stories: A Podcast of Honor and Memory**

**Approximate Duration:** 8 class periods (55 min classes) + 1 Presentation Night

## **Materials Needed:**

- Chromebook
- Internet access
- Canva software
- Spotify or similar app for listening to podcasts
- Research outline template

## **Day 2**

- More exploration of Centropa Database
- By the end of the period, person selected/approved for podcast

## **Day 3**

- Complete research outline using Centropa Database

## **Day 4**

- Technology specialist spends the period going over the basics of creating a podcast using Canva
- Helpful video of easy step by step instructions

### Day 5

- Using outline, create podcast script keeping mind the 4 min minimum - 5 min maximum duration requirement

### Day 6

- PRACTICE DAY! Students will work with their Chromebooks in various quiet locations around campus to practice recording themselves speaking organically about their individual and adjusting fluency speed for time requirement
- Final voice recording by the end of the period

### Day 7-8

- Using Canva, students will build their podcast complete with cover art, music, transitions, and their audio
- \*Technology specialist will be co-teaching today to help with tech issues
- Publish podcasts and save to Google Classroom
- Upload Bibliography document to Google Classroom

### Presentation Night

- Students present their podcasts 6 per classroom, for "An Evening of Honor and Remembrance"
- 6:00 pm in school building - 8th grade hallway - Each student has brought in a meaningful, personal item of connection to present at the end of their podcast (grandmother's recipe book, teddy bear, playing cards, photo of similarity to the one of their individual on the cover art, designer Nikes, flag of Moldova, etc.) and share with the audience its significance to both the student and individual they have honored.
