water. *It'll fell like more*



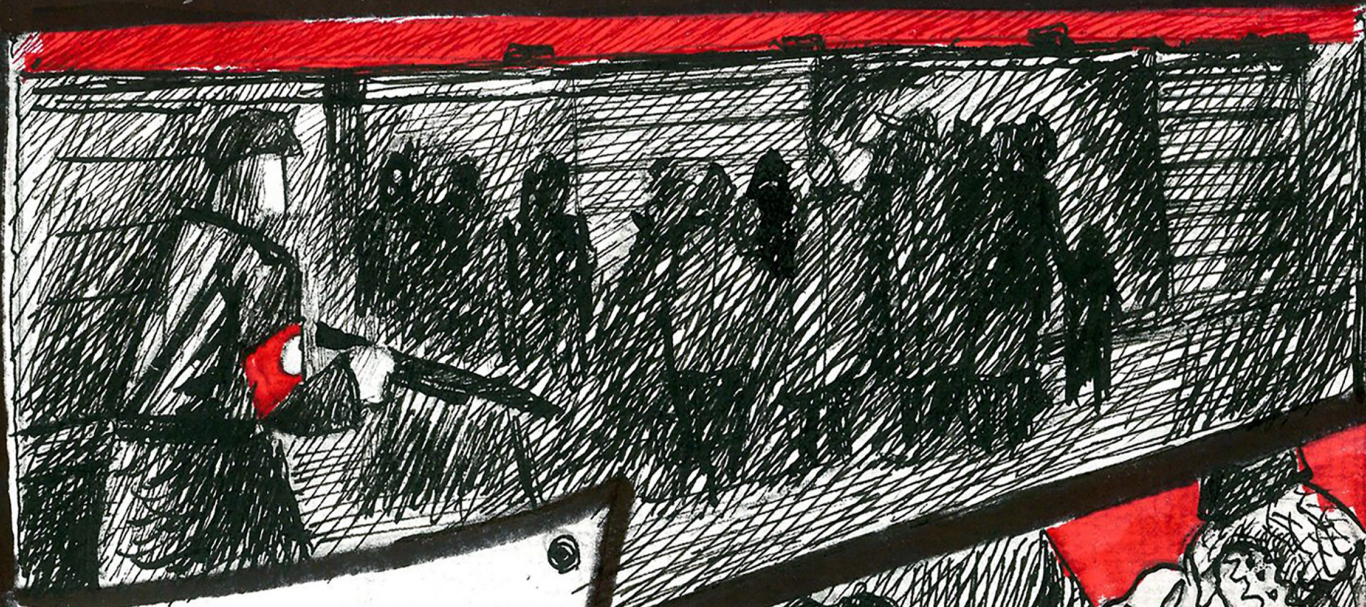


They came for us. They
